

# Righteousness OF God

-Establishing our righteousness

1.) Believing

**Romans 4:3** *Abraham believed and it was counted unto him righteousness.*

2.) What do we believe in?

Abraham believed God in that he was faithful to do that which he had promised

**Romans 5:17** *they (you and I) which receive the abundance of grace and the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.*

\*We have to believe that by the blood of Jesus we are made righteous we are justified. There is no atonement other than him that is pure enough to justify our unrighteousness. The blood of God was the only way to become righteous.

**Romans 4:24** *assuring us that God will also count us as righteous if we believe in him.*

3.) Not only a form of righteousness the righteousness OF God

**2 Corinthians 5:21** *For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we may be made the righteousness of God in him.*

\*Through our belief in Jesus by his blood we are made whole, complete, worthy to obtain our inheritance. Righteous to enter into intimacy with the creator our father. This is not self-righteousness it is God righteousness. This form of righteousness is unattainable to our nature. This is why we have to be born again. A new creature one which is of the Spirit. Our righteousness is not like Gods.... it is Gods.

**Philippians 3:9** *And be found in him, not having my own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith*

**1 Corinthians 15:34** *Awake to righteousness*

\* When the Holy Spirit convicts a believer it isn't what we think of as conviction he reminds us how much bigger we are, how much greater we are. He reminds us of our righteousness (Gods righteousness) He whispers to us we're not under the power of sin we are under the power of liberty. Our sin isn't imputed unto us anymore. We are not held accountable any longer for our short comings. We are reminded of who we are, a child of the almighty all sin and lack is under our feet we reign far above and do

not need sin to fill us. What we are filled with will never cease, there is no lack, no need that cannot be met by our father.

**John 16:8-11 (Amp)**

**8** *And when He comes, He will convict and convince the world and bring demonstration to it about sin and about righteousness (uprightness of heart and right standing with God) and about judgment:*

**9** *About sin, because they do not believe in Me [trust in, rely on, and adhere to Me.];*

**10** *About righteousness (uprightness of heart and right standing with God), because I go to My Father, and you will see Me no longer;*

**11** *About judgement, because the ruler (evil genius, prince) of this world [Satan] is judged and condemned and sentence already is passed un him.*
